Architectural Rendering

This expansion was developed to improve and increase services provided to the passengers and staff. The C8 Retail Expansion consisted of a 10,000 square-foot multi-level retail, food and beverage center. The concourse level provides several food and specialty retailers strategically located by the highly trafficked elbow of the concourse. These functions are connected by a central service core to an apron level central receiving and provisioning facility complete with dry goods storage, cold storage, trash disposal, and loading docks.

David Mason & Associates provided architectural and interior design, structural, civil engineering, surveying and project and construction management on this addition and renovation.

This project is located on the secure side of the airport facility between existing aircraft loading gates. Extensive design coordination with MEP, security and baggage handling systems was required. Interior design utilizing "Class 1" materials was required for this project.
